On 09-21-00, approximately 1300 hrs., I contacted Ms. Kelly Moffett at the Mainstream Women's Center. The contact was made for the purpose of an interview regarding Ms. Moffett's knowledge of Anastasia Witbolsfeugen's death.

Briefly, Ms. Moffett stated that she saw Byron Case shoot Anastasia Witbolsfeugen in the face\* with what she described as a shotgun. The shooting took place in Lincoln Cemetery in the early evening of 10-22-97. According to Ms. Moffett, Case and Bruton planned to kill Anastasia because she was the biggest problem in Justin's life. Ms. Moffett stated she was asked to telephone Anastasia that evening, but she was unsure if she or not.\*\* After the shooting, they drove to a location near some railroad tracks and Case discarded the weapon.

The interview with Ms. Moffett was tape-recorded, will be transcribed and submitted to the casefile. Refer to the transcript for details obtained from Ms. Moffett.

Ms. Moffett agreed to accompany me and revisit the route and locations they went to on the evening of 10-22-97. This was tentatively scheduled for 09-22-00.

\* Kelly Moffett did not state in her original "confession" that Byron shot Anastasia in the face, only that he shot her "Just in the head." (Kelly Moffett statement 4, 09-21-00, page 13). That Anastasia died of a gunshot blast to the head was not insider information. Kelly Moffett attended Anastasia's funeral, which was open casket; the reconstruction to Anastasia's face was so obvious that a reporter from the Kansas City Pitch made note of it in an article (<http://www.pitch.com/2002-05-16/news/cemetery-plot/>) about the murder.
