 SUPPLEMENT TO DEAD BODY COMPLAINT NUMBER 3/97-11829

ON 10/23/97 AT APPROX 0344 HRS R/D WAS REQUESTED TO RESPOND TO THE WEST END OF LINCOLN CEMETERY JUST WEST OF BLUE RIDGE. R/D WAS TO CONTACT DEPUTY EPPERSON #32 IN REF TO A DEAD BODY. R/D RESPONDED TO THE REQUEST FROM I-70 AND US. 7 HWY IN BLUE SPRING'S MO. AS R/D APPROACHED THE INTERSECTION OF TRUMAN AND STARK R/D TURNED LEFT OFF OF TRUMAN AND PROCEEDED NORTH ON STARK. AT THIS POINT AS R/D WAS APPROACHING BLUE RIDGE R/D NOTICED A WHITE MALE WEARING DARK INCOLOR CLOTHS STANDING JUST INSIDE THE TREE LINE ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF STARK. AS R/D PASSED, THE WHITE MALE EXITED THE TREE LINE AND PROCEEDED NORTH BOUND ON FOOT PUSHING A SHOPPING KART TOWARDS TRUMAN ROAD. R/D TURNED AROUND AND CONDUCTED A PEDESTRIAN CHECK. R/D WAS ASSISTED BY IPD OFFICER FRANK BUNNEY #311. THE PARTY IN QUESTION WAS ID AS STILLWELL, GERALD O. JR, W/M, 05-13-48, SSN [REDACTED] BROTHERS ADDRESS (MIKE STILLWELL) 9711 CRESTVIEW DR. KCMO. 64137. REPORTED PHONE 763-5046. ACCORDING TO MR. STILLWELL HE WAS HOME LESS BUT WOULD VISIT HIS BROTHER IN SOUTH KANSAS CITY WHEN HE NEEDED A PLACE TO CLEAN UP. THE PARTY IN QUESTION I.D. HIM SELF WITH MISC. PAPERS AND A LIBRARY CARD. MR. STILLWELL REPORTED THAT HE COULD BE FOUND ANYWHERE IN THE CITY PICKING UP CANS AND JUNK. MR. STILLWELL STOOD APPROX 5'9" AND WEIGHT APPROX 180 POUNDS.

CONTINUATION REPORT

MR. STILLWELL WAS WEARING A BLUE IN COLOR WIND BREAKER. OVER THE WIND BREAKER HE WAS WEARING A BLUE AND RED PL FLANNEL SHIRT. STILLWELLS PANTS WERE OLD DIRTY BLUE JEANS. STILLWELL WAS ALSO WEARING A OLD PAIR OF TENNIS SHOES BRAND UNKNOWN. THE SHOPPING KART CONTAINED TWENTY TO THIRTY SMASHED CANS, ONE OLD DIRTY HAND BAG WHICH CONTAINED A FEW DIRTY CANS, SCRAP WIRE AND A WRENCH. MR. STILLWELL STATED THAT HE HAD BEEN IN THE AREA ABOUT ONE HOUR BUT WAS NOT GOOD AT KEEPING TRACK OF TIME. WHEN ASKED IF HE HAD BEEN IN ANY OF THE CEMETERIA MR. STILLWELL STATED THAT AT TIMES HE WOULD SLEEP IN THEM BUT DID NOT RECALL BEING IN A CEMETERIA TODAY. MR. STILLWELL THEN STARTED TO RANT AND RAVE ABOUT THE LOW PRICE OF CANS AND MISC. JUNK. IT APPEARED THAT NOT ONLY WAS MR. STKLWELL HOME LESS BUT APPEARED TO HAVE SOME MENTAL PROBLEMS. MR. STILLWELL WAS PHOTOGRAPHED AND RELEASED. RIO CLEARED FOR SERVICE.
