Mr. WitbolsFeugen,

Please comply to the following four (4) items:

1. Stop harassing me, both directly and indirectly.
2. Stop harassing me at my residence (directly or indirectly) by sending me E-mail on my personal computer. Do not communicate with me at my residence, or, try to contact me at my residence in any way.
3. Stop harassing me at my workplace (directly or indirectly) by repeatedly faxing the same document(s) to my workplace.
4. Any NEW, viable or relevant, information that would pertain to the investigation of the death of Anastasia WitbolsFeugen, that you obtain and you wish to give the information to the Jackson County Sheriff Department, you can do so by telephone, fax, or in person, whichever method that is most convenient for you. Do not E-mail any of the information to me by means of my personal computer.

On 08-18-98, I spoke with a newspaper reporter due to you having contacted the reporter asking for the reporter's help with your concerns about the investigation.

The reporter informed me that you said you were unable to receive payment from the life insurance policy (s) that you have for Anastasia and this was due to my not cooperating with the insurance companies. Apparently, you did not inform the reporter you had received payment from one of the insurance companies in which you willingly signed the company's release form. The other insurance company has not paid the benefit because YOU REFUSE to sign that company's release form. The only reason you have not received the death benefit from both of the companies is your unwillingness to follow the company's procedure. I have nothing to do with your not receiving payment, but yet you continue to blame me for this. Why aren't you telling these people the true reason you haven't received all the payments?

The reporter also brought up the discussion you and I had in a "face-to-face conversation" on 07-08-98 about disclosing your identity. You will probably show this document to others, so I will not go into any detail about why we were discussing the disclosure. However, you told me you had no problem with the disclosure if I thought it would help get the necessary information. I also asked you if I could anticipate a complaint from you if the disclosure was made. You told

me you would NOT make any complaints. I have not disclosed your identity to anyone, in the manner in which we were discussing, but you have made NUMEROUS COMPLAINTS about me for just merely talking to you about it. Did you give me your word with the intentions of not keeping it?

The disclosure I made that you keep referring to and that YOU have made public information, has been resolved, and was resolved, before you created the document you have been so freely distributing. Whatever conflict there was between these people, no longer exists, that they are fine now. The "girls mother" told me she never intended for the letter that she sent, to be a formal complaint against me. Unless she was not entirely truthful with me, whatever conflict existed has been resolved. Why do YOU keep bringing it up?

In this document you prepared you wrote, "Glenn Colliver, the caretaker of Mt. Washington Cemetery, said that he told investigators everything he knew about the victim. JCSD has maintained that his information was of no significance".

What is your source of information that you can write JCSD "maintained" the information to be of no significance? Who told you that JCSD believed the "caretaker's" information was insignificant. The information received from the "caretaker" was the first step in obtaining the identity of Anastasia. There is absolutely no truth to what you are saying. The JCSD believed then and still does, that the information received from the "caretaker" is significant. I have explained all this to you before.

Responding again to your other concerns in the document you prepared, probably would not make any difference in the position you have taken. Therefore I will not comment about those concerns, at this time.

I believe that your harassment of me has caused irreparable damage to me personally and professionally. I believe this was your intention.

Despite what you have done to me personally and professionally, I am still optimistic that the information and/or evidence needed to solve this case will eventually surface and the truth will be known.

The case is still open, the case is still unsolved, as far as I am concerned.
