On 01-22-98, at approximately 1055 hrs., I contacted Robert Witbolsfeugen at his workplace.

I asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen about the email he sent in which he refers to a "beauty contest" at the cemetery.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he recalled Justin calling Anastasia a queen in the past and that he also remembers a photograph of Tara McDowell wearing a small crown. These recollections coupled with his possible large group in the cemetery scenario and he concluded this. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated the "beauty contest" is just an "hypothesis" he came up with.

I also asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen about his comment about there being a lot of traffic out that night. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he observed several strings of cars on Truman Rd. that passed by him.

I asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen what he based his conclusion on regarding the Sheriff's Department being shorthanded that night (10-22-97). Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he goes through Blue Summit on Truman Rd. at 2000 or so, on his way home from work. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated that he usually see's a Sheriff's car at one of the stations or parked at the top of the hill.

On 10-22-97, when he was out looking for Anastasia Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he didn't see any Sheriff's cars in the area.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he has made contact with a few of the Deputies since that night, giving them flyers and asking if they are aware of the situation. These Deputies have made comments to him about being shorthanded.

I did not ask Mr. Witbolsfeugen if he always see's Sheriff's cars in the area of where Anastasia was last seen, why didn't he notify JCSD that she was missing that night.
