On 02-02-98, at approximately 1050 hrs., I was contacted by Robert Witbolsfeugen.


Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he had made contact with Tara McDowell and had tape-recorded an interview with her. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated Karen Turner was also present during the interview. Apparently Ms. McDowell would now be receptive to my contacting her. Mr. Witbolsfeugen briefed me on what Ms. McDowell told him.

I also asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen if he was positive he saw the white Pontiac with the license Morbid that night. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he was positive. The vehicle was 6<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> in the procession, but he could not see the driver very well because the vehicle was "going pretty fast".

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he did not know what kind of vehicle Case had prior to 10-22-97. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated Patrick Rock took the photograph of Byron's vehicle and Witbolsfeugen is positive the vehicle in the photograph is the same as the vehicle he saw that night.

I asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen what he meant in his email about he hopes there is plenty of room in the County Jail. Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated that a friend of Rock's named Lloyd Johnson has two sons and he believes they have information regarding the homicide. Apparently, Johnson read about the homicide in the paper and had made a comment to Rock that his sons had told him that there was about a dozen people at the cemetery that night (10-22-97), indicating they did have some information. Johnson told Rock he would speak further about this with his sons.
