On 09-03-99, at approximately 1045 hrs. I was contacted by Robert Witbolsfeugen.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen inquired about the status of the investigation and I told him there was no change. Mr. Witbolsfeugen then began going over the entire case as he saw it.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated, that when he saw Steve Elliott a year after the homicide, it reminded Mr. Witbolsfeugen of a person he saw in one of the cars he saw in the caravan on Truman Rd. on 10-22-97.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen remembers saying to himself "Steve is probably still shaking in his boots". Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated Elliott is not going to say anything because if he does, "he might as well say goodbye to this world, because they know where the story came from".

Mr. Witbolsfeugen still maintains Byron Case knows something but won't talk for fear of being killed. Mr. Witbolsfeugen believes Abraham Kneisiy was probably the one putting pressure on Case.
