On 11-05-97, at approximately 1130 hrs., I accompanied Mr. Witbolsfeugen to his residence, 427 Delaware Indep. Mo., in order to recover what he believes to be bone fragments of his daughter's skull.

Prior to recovering any item, I had Mr. Witbolsfeugen sign a handwritten consent to search form.

After entering the residence, Mr. Witbolsfeugen went directly to a roll top desk in the the dining area of the residence. Mr. Witbolsfeugen removed from the top left desk drawer a clear plastic bag, which contained small pieces of a brown colored hard substance. The pieces had a red colored substance on the surface. These pieces appeared to be plastic.


I asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen if I could see Anastasia's room and Mr. Witbolsfeugen to her room.

Apparently Anastasia's property was in the process of being boxed. Inside a box setting on the floor, I observed several items. Included were numerous unused tampons. I asked Mr. Witbolsfeugen if these belonged to Anastasia and he stated they did.

The following items were recovered from Anastasia's room:

- 1- Forenza brand blue jeans, size 8
- 1- Arizona brand blue jeans, size 9
- 1- Time Pieces brand, pullover sweater black in color, size large.
- 1- Blank VHS video tape
- 1- Cure Show, video tape
- 1- Black binder notebook
- 1- Pink w/floral design, small binder notepad
