On 12-01-97, at approximately 1530 hrs., Robert Witbolsfeugen contacted me.

I informed Mr. Witbolsfeugen I had received Justin's answering machine, but I had not had the opportunity to listen to any of the messages.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen began making comments about the lack of a close relationship between Mr. Bruton and Justin. Anastasia told Mr. Witbolsfeugen that Justin and his father were not close.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated he would be interested in knowing if there was a message on the machine from Mr. Bruton, prior to his arrival in Kansas City. Mr. Witbolsfeugen was suggesting that Mr. Bruton was aware of the situation and Justin's involvement. Mr. Witbolsfeugen asked me if I was aware of what kind of cars and if we knew the license numbers for Byron Case and "Alex". Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated that maybe Mr. Bruton had come to K.C. with another car and switched vehicles with Justin.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen is "rambling" nearly ever contact I have with him. During this particular conversation he even excused himself for "babbling". Mr. Witbolsfeugen's comments, etc. are making little or sense.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen stated to me he would be interested in knowing what evidence we had that would place people at the cemetery. He would also be interested in the evidence that would show what kinds of cars that might have been in the cemetery.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen expressed a concern that we would discontinue the investigation and he was told the investigation would continue no matter how long it would take.

Mr. Witbolsfeugen inquired about Anastasia's computer and I told him I would get it to him as soon as I could.
