On 09-10-98, at approximately 1145 hrs., I contacted Mr. Michael Sanders, attorney for Byron Case.

At that time, I asked Mr. Sanders if he had heard back from Byron Case and Mr. Sanders stated he had not (regarding an interview).

Mr. Sanders stated the information from Case is that his vehicle was in the shop being repaired during the time of Anastasia's murder. The vehicle was towed from in front of a friend's house (possibly Moffett) and taken to Burch Automotive where it stayed for approximately two (2) weeks. Mr. Sanders stated Case's father paid the tow company, but he did not know which tow company it was. Mr. Case (father) paid for the tow by check and banked at the Brotherhood Bank.

Mr. Sanders stated that if I had any further questions I should contact him and he would get the answer from Case. Mr. Sanders stated he does not believe Case knows anymore than what he has already told me. Mr. Case is concerned we are going to try and "pin" this on him, or, a lawsuit was going to be brought against him.

I informed Mr. Sanders that Jeff Busher was willing to offer immunity to Case as long as he was not involved in the murder.

Mr. Sanders stated to have Mr. Busher contact him so they could work out the details.
